The Five Alignment Moves

That Deliver Results

1 Start with strategic alignment

"If you don't define what matters, everything will feel urgent."

Before you roll out big changes, make sure you know what success looks like for you, for your team, and for the people counting on you.

2 Build habits that create stability

"Systems are stronger than willpower."

SHARPE Element	Who It's For	What It Helps You Do
Strategic Alignment	For leaders who want every action to connect to the bigger picture	Make sure every decision ladders up to your vision
Habits	For those ready to lead with rhythm, not reactivity	Create powerful routines that stick and scale
Accountability	For teams that need clarity, ownership, and momentum	Move things forward with purpose and structure
Relationships	For leaders building trust across silos and stakeholders	Lead with emotional intelligence and real connection
Performance	For teams that want to deliver meaningful results—not just stay busy	Focus on what moves the needle
Execution	For teams that start strong but stall before the finish	Deliver with clarity, speed, and consistency
